Faculty of Forestry is offering Tropical Forest Trail - witness the heritage for today and tomorrow. This summer programme will expose students to the importance of forests for society and the world. This is the opportunity for students to explore one of Malaysia's tropical rainforests.

Participants will have the opportunity to experience for themselves being in a natural tropical rainforest. Students will develop their knowledge and understanding about forest ecosystems, and learn forestry skills through a variety of activities including forest survival, identifying herbs and ferns, and outdoor recreation activities such as flying fox and forest canopy walk.

Exploring Malaysia's tropical rainforest.

Ayer Hitam Reserved Forest (HSAH) is a 1182 hectare land and a natural hidden treasure that is invaluable and yet is conveniently located in the Klang Valley. Rich with flora and fauna inhabiting the rainforest, this gem trades carbon and is essential for the survival of humankind.
